Staffing Update - We are pleased to announce that Nicole Oviatt is returning to Bruderheim School as our Music Teacher, and we will welcome her back on April 19! We also want to say a heartfelt thank you to Alison Janzen for her service and dedication to our school while she served as our Music Teacher!

Grade 1 Intervention Funds - We will begin providing small-group intervention in the areas of literacy and numeracy for select students who scored in the 25th percentile or below on the Government Literacy and Numeracy Screeners which were completed earlier this year. This intervention will be provided by Kerry-Lynn Hoekman from April 24 until June 1, 2023.

Before & After School Care, 2023-24 - Continues to be on track and will be offered to Bruderheim School families next year. We are waiting on further and finalized information regarding location and cost.

Collection of School Fees for 2022-23 - We have only collected 36% of Noon Hour Supervision fees as of the end of March. It would be very helpful if these fees were paid. They are posted and can be paid on the Parent Portal. We already cover a significant portion (32%) of the cost for noon hour supervision in our school budget and the increased cost from unpaid fees take funds from our school budget. We will keep the fees the same for 2023-24, but again, we need to have these fees paid.

Budget 2023-2024

The Provincial budget was announced at the end of February. It is said to be a fairly good news budget for education, but boards are still working out the details as to how it will affect each board. EIPS board has met regarding the budget and more details on specifics will follow.

New Sherwood Heights School Build

Construction funding has been announced for the new Sherwood Heights School in Sherwood Park. The new build combines Ecole Campbell Town Elementary and Sherwood Heights Junior High into one new school on the current Sherwood Heights location.

LOGOS Program

Motion was passed at the March 16, 2023, board meeting to combine the LOGOS program, currently at two sites: Brentwood Elementary and Westboro Elementary, at Brentwood Elementary beginning September 2023. The combining of the program will help ensure that the

program can continue as enrolment at both sites was declining.

2024-2027 Three-Year Capital Plan Approval

The Board approved the new plan at the March 16, 2023, board meeting. Number one on the capital plan is a new high school for Fort Saskatchewan: combining the current Rudolf Hennig Junior and Fort Saskatchewan High School into one 7-12 High school.
